National Championships will take place in
Atlanta, GA June 21-25, 2021
Deadline: July 10, 2021
The competition is open to SkillsUSA national winners and high school
seniors graduating in 2021.
Tuition scholarships are awarded in the following categories:
Web Design (12), Television (12), Advertising (6), Culinary (6),
Photography (6), and Animation (12)
(number based on team competition)
1st place: \$12,000 tuition scholarship
2nd place: \$5,000 tuition scholarship

FCCLA (Family Consumer and Community Leaders of America)*

National Championships will take place in
Nashville, TN June 27-July 1, 2021.
The competition is open to FCCLA national winners and high school
