

Student Retention Rate: The Art Institute of Atlanta

According to regulations published by the Department of Education, schools must make available to current and prospective students the retention rate of certificate or degree seeking, first-time undergraduate students as reported to IPEDS. The IPEDS retention rate of first-time, full-time bachelor's seeking undergraduate students at **The Art Institute of Atlanta** as reported to IPEDS is **45%**. The retention rate for first-time, part-time bachelor's seeking undergraduate students, as reported to IPEDS is **41%**.

The retention rate is calculated based on the number of first-time bachelor's students who entered school in Fall 2018 and were still enrolled as of Fall 2019.
