In accordance with guidelines established by The Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA), all programs wishing to apply for and maintain CIDA accreditation must collect and publish student data to ensure the public has access to clear and reliable information addressing various aspects of program enrollment and student achievement.

Student Retention: Student retention data was queried from the student information system using enrollment statuses for the 2016-2017 school year, October 2016 to October of 2017. Six students who matriculated into the Interior Design program in the fall of 2016 returned in the fall of 2017 resulting in a retention rate of **40%**.

Graduation Rates: Graduation rates for the 2016-2017 school year were calculated using data from the student information system for the period of September 2016 to June of 2017. There were 20 Interior Design students who graduated in the 2016-2017 school year; **55%** of these students completed the program in four years.

Acceptance into Graduate Programs: There were **no** Interior Design students who graduated in the 2016-2017 school year and then applied for graduate school.

Job Placement Rates: Job placement data for the 2016-2017 school year were calculated using data from the student information system for the period of September 2016 to June 2017. **37%** of the Interior Design students who graduated in the 2016-2017 school year are employed in interior design or a related profession.
