



Sample PsyD Five-Year, 98 Credit Hour Curriculum

Student progress through the Clinical Psychology program at Argosy University, Tampa is intended to be **sequential**. Certain courses offered to first-year students are designed to provide a theoretical and practical foundation for courses that follow in subsequent years. In addition, certain advanced courses require the student to have the background of more basic courses in order to benefit fully from the course experience. The following is a **sample schedule**.
