Argosy University (www.argosy.edu), with 26 campus locations in 13 states and online, is a private, nonprofit academic institution dedicated to providing undergraduate and graduate degree programs to students through its eight colleges: College of Clinical Psychology, College of Counseling, Psychology and Social Sciences, Graduate School of Business and Management, College of Education, College of Health Sciences, College of Arts and Sciences, College of Creative Arts and Design and Western State College of Law at Argosy University.

With one of the largest communities of graduate students in the nation, Argosy University offers doctoral and master's degree programs in the areas of psychology, behavioral sciences, business, computer animation, counseling, and education. Argosy University is recognized as a 501(c)(3) entity by the Internal Revenue Service, Department of the Treasury.

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WHAT WE DO

Offering courses on campus and online, Argosy University is divided into eight colleges. Through Argosy University's Graduate School of Business and Management, students are taught how to manage and how to lead people by integrating business principles with psychology and behavioral sciences. Programs in Argosy University's College of Counseling, Psychology and Social Sciences help students develop the specific competencies required of clinical practitioners.

The College of Clinical Psychology emphasizes the development of knowledge, skills, and attitudes essential in the formation of professional psychologists. Programs offered through Argosy University's College of Education are conducted in a collaborative environment designed to encourage innovation and provide students a chance to explore the historical, philosophical, psychological, technical, theoretical and practical aspects of education and institutional administration.

The College of Health Sciences is committed to preparing students to provide quality health care, by instilling knowledge, skills, and ethical values of professional practice and to fostering values of social responsibility with a commitment to lifelong learning. To meet the need for skilled healthcare professionals, the university offers practitioner-oriented instruction that provides the knowledge and tools that graduates will need to utilize in their careers.

The College of Arts and Sciences offers programs designed to equip students with the communication, critical thinking, and problem-solving skills needed to pursue an entry-level career choice or graduate study in the areas of business, criminal justice, liberal arts, and psychology.

The College of Creative Arts and Design (comprised of the California locations of The Art Institutes system of schools) serves as an important source of education for design, media arts, fashion and culinary students and professionals. Full and part-time law programs are offered through Western State College of Law at Argosy University.
